Giving Warwickshire's children the best start in life

**Warwickshire in support of
Infant Mental Health Awareness Week**

Warwickshire County Council's Smart Start programme is supporting Infant Mental Health Awareness Week which runs from 12-16 June. The week will focus on the mental health and wellbeing of babies in their first 1001 critical days - from conception to 2 years.

A Warwickshire Smart Start workshop held on 23 May 2017 brought together a wide range of agencies and representatives from Warwickshire County Council, NHS, education, third sector and communities to hear from experts in the field of infant mental health and to look at ways of building and strengthening parent-infant mental health and wellbeing support in Warwickshire.



Dr John Linnane, Director of Public Health said “Promoting parent-infant mental health and wellbeing is a priority in Warwickshire. We know that by the time children reach 14 years of age, 50% of them are already experiencing mental health issues. We need to act early – during the first 1001 critical days of a child’s life – in order to give them the best start in life.”
